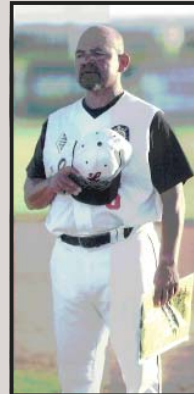

	<b>Lexington Library Fund</b>	A permanent fund for library improvements, literary collections, and programs
<b>Project Development Funds</b>	<b>Heartland Military Museum Fund</b>	A fund established for capital improvements at the military museum
	<b>Optimist Recreational Complex Fund</b>	A permanent fund created to support future upgrades and equipment needs at the Optimist Recreational Complex
	<b>Johnson Lake Trails Fund</b>	Provides matching funds for segments of the Johnson lake trail system
	<b>Majestic Theater Fund</b>	
	<b>YMCA of Lexington</b>	A permanent fund established to support YMCA programming in Lexington
<b>Special Interest Funds</b>	<b>Lexington Concert Fund</b>	Provides the funding necessary to bring a variety of musical talent to Lexington
	<b>Good Samaritan Fund</b>	A donor fund established for the purpose of assisting Lexington students with the unmet basic human needs
	<b>Lexington Baseball Association Fund</b>	A fund to permanently support the Legion baseball program in Lexington
	<b>Lexington Soccer League Fund</b>	
	<b>Lexington Tennis Association Fund</b>	Funds disbursed at the discretion of the Tennis Association for facility improvements
	<b>Club 180 Fund</b>	Contributions to the Club 180 Fund will support youth activities held at Club 180's youth center
	<b>Tri-County Hospital Fund</b>	A fund established in partnership with Tri-County Hospital to accept contributions that will support healthcare programs and services, and improve facilities.
	<b>The Welcome Center Fund</b>	A fund established to support services provided by Lexington's immigration center
<b>Education Funds</b>	<b>Lexington Education Appreciation Fund</b>	A fund created by Lexington school board members in support of LPS teachers and administrators
	<b>Alumni Scholarship Fund</b>	A LCF scholarship created in cooperation with the Lexington Alumni Association
	<b>LHS Class of 1977 Memorial Scholarship Fund</b>	A scholarship fund established by members of the LHS Class of 1977 in memory of their classmates
